## Intersection Improvement Process Overview

### Public involvement is the driving force for design improvement.

- Stakeholders who reside, work, own property, worship, and play in the immediate project area are directly involved in the design process.
- Public input is being collected to help traffic design engineers to find the best solution.
- Constructive engagement and collaboration will ensure that the winning design meets the future needs of the project area stakeholders and the entire community.

### The City of Lincoln is taking a new and innovative approach to finding the best solution.

- A design competition among three traffic engineering firms is a leading-edge approach that will find creative and intelligent ways to address current and future challenges with these intersections.
- Past design efforts did not achieve the full balance necessary to meet the complete needs for traffic improvement and community interests.
- New designs for these intersections will move the community beyond previous incremental improvements to a long-term solution.

### Design process steps ensure the public is involved every step of the way.

- Public input is being front loaded before the actual design competition begins.
- All key stakeholders in the project area have the opportunity for consultation leading to the draft designs.
- Project area stakeholders and the general public will review the design options and provide input before the City of Lincoln announces its final design.
